Here's a brief list of factors that distinguish us from many other elementary school options.

Research shows the Kindergarten through fifth grade years are critically important in childhood development. This is the age when kids learn to love school (or not). We believe that our **kids are worth the investment in an Island School education.**

What are the hallmarks of an Island School education?

- **Small class sizes** - Student-teacher ratio of 10:1
- **Hands-on learning** - field trips, full month of Cultural Study, Market Day, time outside, innovative curriculum focused on project-based learning
- **Love of learning** - kids are excited to come to school every day.
- **Research-based curriculum** - fosters creativity, problem-solving and love of learning
- **Emphasis on social-emotional learning** - research shows these skills are most predictive of long-term individual success
- **Child-centered** - decisions based on what is best for kids
- **Parents as partners** - we welcome parents as volunteers and resources in classrooms and school projects
- **Students learn in mixed-age activities** - learning and reading buddies, calendar project, Cultural Study.
- **Recess** - two 30 minute recesses every day outside on our **forested campus**
